Ray Bates called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Previous Meeting Minutes:

Richard H. Gray, Jr. made a motion to approve the October 29, 2019 minutes as read seconded by Andrew Ballantyne and approved 5-0-0.

Public Works – Keith Hall:

a) Ray Bates asked about the on-road diesel fuel tank situation which went into much discussion. Theresa said that we will be moving forward with this.

Transfer Station – Timothy Coston:

- a) The monthly report shows that the Transfer Station is down by (\$1,635.90) for the month of October compared to October 2018 and that it is down by (\$1,015.35) for July through October compared to last year.
- b) Tim said that they are coming Friday to drain Freon.

- c) Theresa said that she had some good news that the cost of the health benefits only went up 3% and she said that she had budgeted a 6% increase so this will be a help. There was no change on the dental insurance.
- d) There is a recall on the 2018 Ford F-550 regarding possible door freezing but to take no action unless this should happen, then we can make an appointment and it will be fixed at no cost to us.
- e) We have an opportunity to purchase 6 snow tires with rims for the new Ford F-550 with rims for approximately \$2,000.00.
- f) Theresa said that Christmas is on a Wednesday this year and suggested that the Board of Selectmen meeting should be on Monday, December 23rd instead of the of the 24th.
