<u>Public Comment</u>—Resident Tom Reed commented that the Kelley gravel pit across from the Windsor Fairgrounds is expanding noticeably towards Route 32.

Planning Board Materials: The Planning Board discussed the organization of the Planning Board's maps and other materials. Town of Windsor Deputy Clerk Debbie French had gathered and provided the Board copies of State rules and guidelines for retention and disposal of government records. CMP Project: The Town Manager reported that Central Maine Power Co. may be considering expansion of the new substation, but the expansion will be within the existing footprint of the substation so it is not likely to require Planning Board review.
