

MINUTES OF WINDSOR EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION AND REED FUND APRIL 11, 2022 WINDSOR TOWN OFFICE

Bonnie Squiers made a motion to approve the minutes dated January 10, 2022, as printed, seconded by Ray Chavarie, and approved 5-0-0.

Theresa handed out the quarterly balances and they are as follows:

- 3. Jana Diket is asking for supplies for the fresh water tank within her classroom in the amount of \$59.52.
- 4. April Spencer, 3rd Grade is looking to benefit the whole school by having Stephen McCloskey of the WDC (Whale and Dolphin Conservation) come in and do an onsite of Deliah the life sized, walk through inflatable whale along with a presentation about right whale protection in the amount of \$848.00.

Ray Chavarie voted no.

<u>Theresa Haskell make a motion to approve \$425.10 for the 2nd Grade Class go to Mr. Drew and his</u> <u>Animals Too, seconded by Bonnie Squiers and approved 4-0-1.</u> Ray Chavarie voted no.
