#### Call to Order

# **Previous Meeting Minutes, Consideration & Action**

Jerry Nault moved that the minutes from April 10, 2023 Special Planning Board meeting be accepted as written. Jeffrey Murch seconded, all approved, 5-0.

## New Business—

<u>Wedding Venue</u>. Michael Murphy discussed his plan to create a 200-person capacity wedding venue at his property, know as the Whittaker Farm. He has had discussions with the State Fire Marshall's Office regarding fire code requirements. He has also discussed Windsor Building Code requirements with the Windsor CEO. The Planning Board determined that no Planning Board permits are required, and the project may go forward as long as all other required permits are obtained.

<u>Choate and Shuman Road Subdivision.</u> Caleb Coffin of Coffin Engineering presented a preliminary subdivision application and site plan map for a subdivision at the corner of Choate and Shuman Roads. The property owner, Nick Hall, had purchased 5.13 acres of a parcel owned by Bill McFarland. He divided that property into two 2+ acre parcels. By doing so he triggered the need for subdivision approval. The Planning Board reviewed the preliminary materials. Mr. Coffin will complete the application requirements and return to the Planning Board for final approval.

<u>Three-sided shed.</u> Justin and Jennifer Doades appeared before the Planning Board to discuss their intention to build a 30-foot by 25-foot three-sided shed on their property. Eventually they hope to use

the property as an educational facility. The Planning Board determined that no Planning Board permits are required, only a Windsor Building permit.
