the above-named highway is **CLOSED UNLESS SOLIDLY FROZEN** to all vehicles or combinations of vehicles, except:

- a. Any vehicle or combinations of vehicles registered for a gross weight of 23,000 pounds or less.
- b. Any vehicle or combination of vehicles registered for a gross weight in excess of 23,000 pounds and traveling without a load other than tools necessary for proper operation of the vehicle. This exception does not apply to special mobile equipment.
- c. Any vehicle engaged in highway maintenance under the direction of the Maine Department of Transportation or the municipal officers of this town.
- d. Any home heating fuel delivery truck registered in excess of 23,000 pounds which has an exemption certificate issued by the Maine Department of Transportation. Exempt trucks shall not carry loads exceeding _____ pounds gross weight.
- e. Any vehicle with a special permit issued by the Maine Department of Transportation to travel over posted roads, a wrecker towing a disabled vehicle, emergency vehicles, school buses, and vehicles with three axles or less under the direction of a public utility and engaged in plant maintenance or repair.

"Solidly frozen" means that the air temperature is below 32°F and there is no liquid water showing in cracks or potholes. Both conditions are required for road to be considered solidly frozen.

Except when the way is solidly frozen, it shall be unlawful for any prohibited vehicle or combination of vehicles to pass over the section of highway described above.

AS OF FEBRUARY 12, 2024**

The named roads below are **CLOSED UNLESS SOLIDLY FROZEN** to all vehicles or combinations of vehicles over 23,000 pounds Pursuant to 29-A, M.R.S.A. 2395 and the provisions of the Town of Windsor unless a permit is issued.

“Solidly frozen” means that the air temperature is below 32 Degrees Fahrenheit and there is no liquid water showing in cracks or potholes. Both conditions are required for the road to be considered solidly frozen.

We have posted the roads to prevent damage from heavy truck traffic traveling over our roads when they are thawed and the soil material under the road is wet to prevent significant structural damage that may happen.
