



Appealing FEMA's Decision

Every applicant who disagrees with FEMA's decision has the right to appeal.

What you will need:

- Applicant's full name, disaster-damaged primary address, current address and current phone number
- Applicant's 9-digit FEMA application number on each page, found at the top of the determination letter.
- FEMA disaster declaration number DR 4754 (on every page)
- Letter explaining what you disagree with (denial or amount you received if approved)
- Applicant's signature and the date.
- Additional documentation to support your appeal (verifiable contractor's estimate, insurance paperwork, any additional documents FEMA requested in the determination letter)

How to submit

- Upload to your account on DisasterAssistance.gov,
 Click "Check Status" on the home page and follow the instructions.
- fax to 800-827-8112 Attn: FEMA, or
- visit your nearest Disaster Recovery Center (DRC) and submit your appeal.
