

RECYCLING GUIDE

As you enter the grounds of the Transfer Station-Recycling Center and take a right, the first section you pass is reserved for recyclable materials. Here's a handy guide to make you aware of what recycling opportunities are available to Windsor residents.

PAPER

Mixed Paper, Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs and Phone Books.

Please place in the marked container which may contain any of the following: Brown Kraft Paper (brown paper bags), letters, folders, flyers, envelopes, white or colored paper, computer paper, photocopies, NCR paper, calendars, brochures, canceled checks, adding machine tapes, cereal boxes, egg cartons, shoe boxes, milk cartons and drink boxes.

NO FOIL, RIBBON, PLASTIC OF ANY KIND, INTERLEAF CARBON PAPER OR GLITTER.

Corrugated Cardboard is double-sided with a zigzag center. Please flatten boxes and keep them dry and clean.

GLASS

ONLY Clear, Green and Brown Glass jars and bottles are accepted. Each should be rinsed clean and sorted by color and placed at the designated location at the Recycling Center. Lids should be removed. Labels do not need to be removed.

WINDOW GLASS, DRINKING GLASSES, COOKING PLATES, OR LIGHT BULBS ARE NOT ACCEPTED.

PLASTICS

2 Plastic ONLY
(chasing triangle with # inside)

Bins are clearly marked for recycling.

Rinse clean and separate by color into bins at the Recycling Center.

Milk jugs - need to be rinsed clean, and placed in the bin provided.

NO PLASTIC BAGS OR OTHER NUMBERED PLASTICS

METAL

Tin Cans

Rinse, Clean and Place in designated location

Think REDUCE when you shop.

Reduce the amount of packaging you buy and avoid plastic whenever possible.

REUSE - the possibilities are limited only by your imagination!
