Scholarship awards will be given to students ages 25 years and younger who wish to enroll in a degree and must be a resident of Windsor and have resided here for the past seven (7) years continuously. Verification of your residency is required. Scholarships will be awarded in amounts up to \$2,500.00 per year.
