RECYCLING GUIDE

As you enter the grounds of the Transfer Station-Recycling Center and take a right, the first section you pass is reserved for recyclable materials. Here's a handy guide to make you aware of what recycling opportunities are available to Windsor residents.

PAPER

Mixed Paper, Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs and Phone Books.

Please place in the marked container which may contain any of the following: Brown Kraft Paper (brown paper bags), letters, folders, flyers, envelopes, white or colored paper, computer paper, photocopies, NCR paper, calendars, brochures, canceled checks, adding machine tapes, cereal boxes, egg cartons, shoe boxes, milk cartons and drink boxes.

NO FOIL, RIBBON, PLASTIC OF ANY KIND, INTERLEAF CARBON PAPER OR GLITTER.

<u>Corrugated Cardboard</u> is double-sided with a zigzag center. Please flatten boxes and keep them dry and clean.

GLASS

ONLY Clear, Green and Brown Glass jars

and bottles are accepted. Each should be rinsed clean and sorted by color and placed at the designated location at the Recycling Center. Lids should be removed. Labels do not need to be removed.

WINDOW GLASS, DRINKING GLASSES, COOKING PLATES, OR LIGHT BULBS ARE <u>NOT</u> ACCEPTED.

PLASTICS

<u># 2 Plastic ONLY</u> (chasing triangle with # inside)

Bins are clearly marked for recycling.

Rinse clean and separate by color into bins at the Recycling Center.

<u>Milk jugs</u> - need to be rinsed clean, and placed in the bin provided.

NO PLASTIC BAGS OR OTHER NUMBERED PLASTICS

<u>METAL</u>

<u>Tin Cans</u> Rinse, Clean and Place in designated location

Think REDUCE when you shop.

Reduce the amount of packaging you buy and avoid plastic whenever possible.

NO CHARGE FOR RECYCLING!!

Any materials presented for recycling are at no cost.

Hazardous materials and any liquids will not be accepted.

Check with Personnel before leaving <u>on any</u> questionable materials or liquids.

Brush and Wood

The Transfer Station accepts brush

and natural wood. *Wood is considered construction debris and shall be*

deposited into the Bulky Container.

The charge for brush and wood deposits are as follows;

20¢ PER POUND

Speed Limit - 5 MPH

The space for depositing household trash and items for recycling is small and there may be many users present at any one time. Please drive carefully and at a slow speed when on the grounds of the Transfer Station. A maximum speed of 5 miles per hour is recommended.

User Fees

To help defray the tax burden associated with the Transfer Station and encourage use of the Recycling Center, the voters authorized the Town Select Board to institute user fees for disposal of most trash items.
